## ENTRY FEES

**Singles: \$30** (Prize \$18, Bowling \$8, Tourn. Exp. \$4)

**Doubles: \$20** per team (Prize \$16, Exp. \$4)

**Team Event: \$20** per team

### Tournament Rules

- No less than 2 per lane.
- Entries close with the last shift.
- Bowl as many times as you wish, but only collect once in the top 20 in singles.
- 100% prize money returned.
- ENTERING AVERAGE TO BE USED must meet the following rules. Bowlers shall use the highest average based on: (5a.) Stated average (usually sanctioned league average); (5b.) rerated or adjusted average based on tournament performance; or (5c.) adjusted average based on Duke's tournament performance. Failure to report correct average according to these rules may result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees and prize winnings.
- 5a. Stated Entering Ave. Rule: Use last year's (2009-10 highest league average with a minimum of 21 games, or if no ave. last year, you can use your highest current ave. with a minimum of 21 games as your stated average. No traveling league ave. or summer league averages allowed. A 2008-09 league average may be accepted at the discretion of the tournament director. Anyone without an acceptable league average will bowl scratch (210 average), except as noted in 5c.
- 15 PIN HIGHER RULE: If your highest average as of day of bowling is 15 pins or more above your previous season's average, the current average will be used for your stated average.

- Rerated/adjusted average. (5b.1) If USBC, associations or tournaments have rerated your average, you must use the rerated average if higher than your stated league average. (5b.2) If you have been barred or disqualified from any tournament, you must report the fact to the tournament director prior to bowling for possible rerating in this tournament. (5b.3) Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$600.00 or more in any event in a tournament within the previous 12 month period, must report actual score, position and amount won for possible rerating. (5b.4) USBC Rule 319 applies to ALL ENTRANTS, to include: A bowlers entering average must be adjusted if during the 12 month period immediately preceding the date of bowling: (5b.4a) His accumulated average in all - but not less than 21 tournament games exceeds his entering (stated) average by 15 pins or more. OR (5b.4b) He has exceeded his entering (stated) average by 15 or more pins per game in 5 tournaments - based on his high series in each tournament.

- (5c.) Adjustment Based on Duke's Tournament Performance. All bowlers are subject to average adjustment based on performance in Duke's Tournament and prize winnings. It is the bowler's responsibility to report tournament scores according to these rules. (5c.1.) If you have placed more than once in the top 20 positions in singlet in the last 5 years (or last 5 times you bowled here, whichever is longer) and your cumulative avg. (3 high each time) exceeds your stated avg., adjust your stated average using the

- Following: with less than 12 games bowled use 50% of the difference between your stated average and the average of your highest two 3 game totals; with 12 or more games bowled use 50% of the difference between your stated average and your highest 3 game totals each time you bowled. (5c.2) If you have cashed in singles 3 or more times in the last five years (or last 5 times you've bowled here, whichever is longer) and your cumulative average for the last five years (using your 3 high each time) in the Duke's Tournament exceeds your stated average by 15 or more pins, your entering average shall be your stated average from (5a) plus 50% of the difference between that and your cumulative average. (5c.3) If you have no acceptable stated average from rule (5a.), your entering average will be set at your cumulative average for the last five years (using your 3 high out of 4 games each time you bowled in the Duke's Tournament).
- Handicap will be 80% of the difference of the entering average from rule 5 and 210. Maximum handicap will be 80 pins per game.
- All top 20 winners' averages must be verified.
- Tournament director reserves the right to assign starting lanes.
- The Tournament Director and Staff will have the right to accept or reject all entries and decide all questions or disputes arising in the Tournament. All decisions by the Tournament Staff regarding prizes will be considered final as published.

- The Tournament Staff reserve the right to adjust any ave./hdcp./score up to one month after final date of tournament if allowed by these rules.
- Entries will be returned or adjusted in prizes, if war, fire, labor strike, act of God or any other cause makes it impossible or impractical to conduct or complete the Tournament and its publicized prize list and there shall be no further liability of the DUKE'S Classic 3 HIGH OUT OF 4 TOURNAMENT to entrants.
- As a condition of entry we reserve the right to weigh any ball used in Tournament. All bowlers using balls that do not meet USBC specifications, concerning weight, balance, size and hardness will be disqualified and will forfeit their entry fee and any prize money.
- In case of mechanical failure, the Tournament Director has the right to reassign lanes.
- All applicable USBC playing rules apply if not specifically discussed in these rules.

### Doubles Tournament Rules

- Games to be used in the doubles division will be games 2-3-4. No throw out games.
- All other Duke's 3 Hi Out of 4 Singles Tournament rules will apply.

### Team Event Rules

- Bowl on as many teams as you wish. During the same shift, only 3 members can bowl together on another team (must change 2 members).
- Use 3 high out of 4 games.
- Same 5 team members can bowl together again on another shift.
